DIY KNTI BASIC DOG SWEATER IN ROUND WITH USA FLAG [INTARSIA & DUPLICATE ST]

Today I would like to show you how to knit INTARSIA & DUPLICATE ST with my Basic Dog Sweater!

If you've never knitted my basic dog sweater, you might want to watch it first.

I'll show you how in this tutorial, but not real beginner friendly!

YARN: CARRON SIMPLY SOFT

COLOR: 4 COLORS

NEEDLE: 4 MM

SWATCH: 4" (ACROSS): 20 STS

DOG: YORKIE 11 LB

NECK MEASUREMENT: 13"

GAUGE:

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4" VS 13" = 20 STS VS [X STS]

$X = (13 \times 20) / 4$

$X = 260 / 4$

$X = 75$

CAST ON: MULTIPLE OF 4 / 74

RIB: (K2, P2) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH / I KNITTED ABOUT 5.5"

INCREASING ROWS UNTIL LEG OPENINGS

SET UP: K1, (PM), K1, (PM), M1L, ALL KNIT

IR1: K UNTIL M, M1R, (SM), K1, (SM), M1L, K UNTIL BEG M

IR2: ALL KNIT

REP IR1 & IR2 UNTIL YOUR DOG'S TOP OF THE LEGS, FINISH ON IR2

AT THE SAME TIME, YOU MAKE A LEASH OPENING (OPTIONAL)

WHENVER YOU ARE READY FOR LEASH OPENING, YOU CAN DO LEASH OPENING

LR1: BO AS MANY AS YOU WANT (MINE 13 STS)

LR2: ADD NEW CASTS SAME # YOU BO IN PREVIOUS ROW (MINE 13 STS)

LEG OPENING: SAME METHOD OF LEASH OPENING: COUNT STS BOTH WAY FROM MID ST

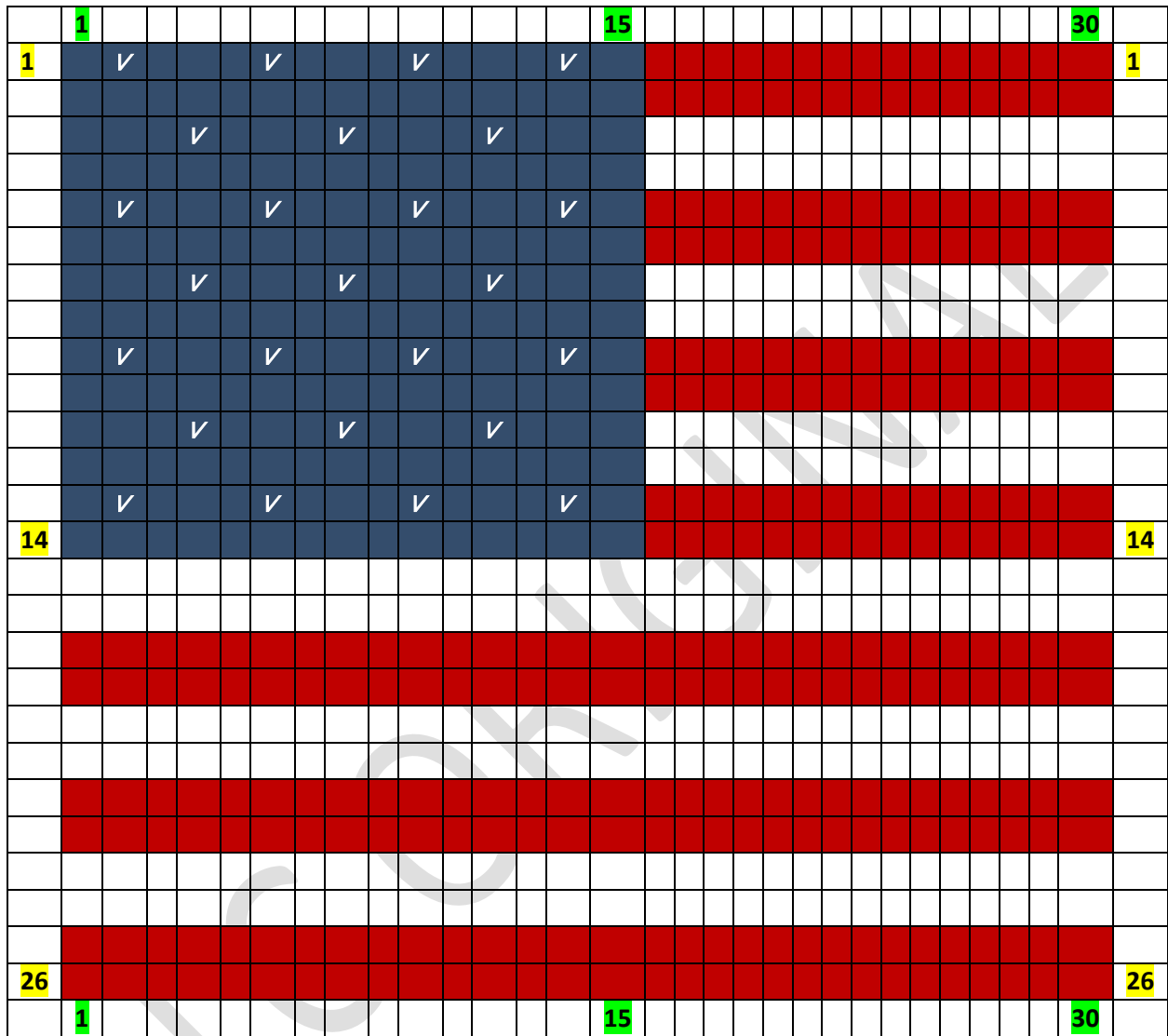
LR1: BO AS MANY AS YOU WANT (MINE 14 STS)

LR2: ADD NEW CASTS SAME # YOU BO IN PREVIOUS ROW (MINE 14 STS)

AFTER LEG OPENING, KEEP KNITTING UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

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[INTARSIA]



TUMMY SHOULD BE SHORTER THAN BACK PS

KNIT UNTIL THE TUMMY M, AND TRANSFER TUMMY STS TO ST HOLDER ON RS

AFTER TRANSFER TUMMY STS, YOU ONLY KNIT BACK PS IN FLAT WITH SOME DECREASING BOTH SIDE WHEN YOU ARE ON RS

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DECREASING ON RS

DR1(RS): K1, SSK, (K & DESIGN) UNTIL LAST 3 STS, K2TOG, K1

DR2(WS): ALL PURL

REP DR1 & DR2 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

RECONNECT FRONT, BACK AND KNIT UP FOR BOTH SIDES

THEN

RIB (K2, P2) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

STRETCHY CAST OFF WITH 1 SIZE BIGGER NEEDLE

Abbreviations

R=ROW

IR=INCREASING ROW

LR=LEASH/LEG OPENING ROW

DR=DECREASING ROW

K=KNIT

P=PURL

KFB=KNIT FRONT & BACK

M1R=MAKE 1 RIGHT

M1L=MAKE 1 LEFT

RS=RIGHT SIDE

WS=WRONG SIDE

SSK=SLIP SLIP KNIT

K2TOG=KNIT 2 TOGETHER

STS=STITCH(ES)

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BO=BIND OFF

M=MARKER
