MY CASTS # IS 70

PATTERN BY BEGINNER'S LUCKRAFT

CAST ON: MULTIPLE OF 2 / 70

RIB: (K1, P1) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH / I KNITTED ABOUT 2"

PREP: ADD MARKERS WHILE YOU KNIT

FOR MID STITCH MARKER: 2ND STITCH: K1, (PM), K1, (PM), M1L, ALL KNIT

FOR BACK DESIGN: MULTIPLE OF 8 + 4: MINE 44 STS (MIN 20 STS)

INCREASING ROWS UNTIL LEG OPENINGS

IR1: K UNTIL M, M1R, (SM), K1, (SM), M1L, K UNTIL BEG M

IR2: ALL KNIT

REP IR1 & IR2 UNTIL YOUR DOG'S TOP OF THE LEGS, FINISH ON IR2

AT THE SAME TIME, YOU MAKE A LEASH OPENING (OPTIONAL)

BACK DESIGN IN ROUND

BR1(RS): ALL KNIT

BR2(WS): P2, K UNTIL LAST 2, P2

BR3(RS): ALL KNIT

BR4(WS): P2, K UNTIL LAST 2, P2

BR5(RS): K2 (C8B) UNTIL LAST 2, K2

BR6(WS): P2, K UNTIL LAST 2, P2

BR7(RS): ALL KNIT

BR8(WS): P2, K UNTIL LAST 2, P2

BR9(RS): ALL KNIT

BR10(WS): P2, K UNTIL LAST 2, P2

BR11(RS): K6, (C8F), UNTIL LAST 6, K6

BR12(WS): P2, K UNTIL LAST 2, P2

REP BR1 ~ BR12 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

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WHENVER YOU ARE READY FOR LEASH OPENING, YOU CAN DO LEASH OPENING

LR1: BO AS MANY AS YOU WANT (MINE 11 STS)

LR2: ADD NEW CASTS SAME # YOU BO IN PREVIOUS ROW (MINE 11 STS)

LEG OPENING: SAME METHOD OF LEASH OPENING: COUNT STS BOTH WAY FROM MID ST

LR1: BO AS MANY AS YOU WANT (MINE 13 STS)

LR2: ADD NEW CASTS SAME # YOU BO IN PREVIOUS ROW (MINE 13 STS)

AFTER LEG OPENING, KEEP KNITTING UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

TUMMY SHOULD BE SHORTER THAN BACK PS

KNIT UNTIL THE TUMMY M, AND TRANSFER TUMMY STS TO ST HOLDER ON RS

AFTER TRANSFER TUMMY STS, YOU ONLY KNIT BACK PS IN FLAT WITH SOME DECREASING BOTH SIDE WHEN YOU ARE ON RS

DECREASING ON RS

DR1(RS): K1, SSK, (DESIGN) UNTIL LAST 3 STS, K2TOG, K1

DR2(WO): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

DR3(RS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

DR4(WO): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

REP DR1 ~ DR4 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

----- OR -----

DR1(RS): K1, SSK, (DESIGN) UNTIL LAST 3 STS, K2TOG, K1

DR2(WO): ALL PURL

REP DR1 ~ DR2 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

BACK DESIGN IN FLAT

R1(RS): ALL KNIT

R2(WS): K2, P UNTIL LAST 2, K2

R3(RS): ALL KNIT

R4(WS): K2, P UNTIL LAST 2, K2

R5(RS): K2 (C8B) UNTIL LAST 2, K2

R6(WS): K2, P UNTIL LAST 2, K2

R7(RS): ALL KNIT

R8(WS): K2, P UNTIL LAST 2, K2

R9(RS): ALL KNIT

R10(WS): K2, P UNTIL LAST 2, K2

R11(RS): K6, (C8F), UNTIL LAST 6, K6

R12(WS): P2, K UNTIL LAST 2, P2

RECONNECT FRONT, BACK AND KNIT UP FOR BOTH SIDES

THEN

RIB (K1, P1) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

STRETCHY CAST OFF – USING 1 SIZE BIGGER NEEDLE

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Abbreviations

R=ROW

IR=INCREASING ROW

LR=LEASH/LEG OPENING ROW

DR=DECREASING ROW

K=KNIT

P=PURL

KFB=KNIT FRONT & BACK

M1R=MAKE 1 RIGHT

M1L=MAKE 1 LEFT

RS=RIGHT SIDE

WS=WRONG SIDE

SSK=SLIP SLIP KNIT

K2TOG=KNIT 2 TOGETHER

STS=STITCH(ES)

BO=BIND OFF

M=MARKER
