A QUITE FEW PEOPLE ASKED ME TO MAKE A VEST TUTORIAL, AND HERE IT IS.

THIS TIME, YOU REALLY HAVE TO MAKE A PLAN AHEAD. PLEASE WATCH MY VIDEO CAREFULLY AND MAKE YOUR OWN PATTERN!

YARN: LOOPS & THREADS SOFT & SHINY #4

NEEDLE: 3.25 MM & 3.5 MM – CIRCULATORY CABLE

SIZE: SMALL

MY 4" X 4" GAUGE: 23 STS & 29 ROWS

CAST ON: MULTIPLE OF 4 / I MADE 200

RIB: (K2, P2) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH / ABOUT 2"

ADD MARKERS FOR FRONT PS FOR SHOULDER PARTS = 100 STS

16, PM, 16(SHOULDER), PM, 36, PM, 16(SHOULDER), PM, 16 = 100 STS

➔ 18, M, 12(SHOULDER), M, 40, M, 12(SHOULDER), M, 18 = 100 STS

FOR PEOPLE WHO IS KNITTING A DIFFERENT SIZES

FOLLOW YOUR PLAN: JUST ADD MARKERS FOR 12 STS OF SHOULDER DESIGN IN THE CENTER OF SHOULDER PARTS

PLACKET: 8 STS IN THE MID OF FRONT PS

CHANGE THE NEEDLE TO 3.5 MM

ALL KNIT ONCE

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LINKING OVALS (IN ROUND) 12 STS

SR1(RS): P4, C4B, P4

SR2(WS): P4, K4, P4

SR3(RS): P3, T3B, T3F, P3

SR4(WS): P3, K2, P2, K2, P3

SR5(RS): P2, T3B, P2, T3F, P2

SR6(WS): P2, K2, P4, K2, P2

SR7(RS): P2, K2, P4, K2, P2

SR8(WS): P2, K2, P4, K2, P2

SR9(RS): P2, T3F, P2, T3B, P2

SR10(WS): P3, K2, P2, K2, P3

SR11(RS): P3, T3F, T3B, P3

SR12(WS): P4, K4, P4

SREP R1 ~ SR12 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

LINKING OVALS (IN FLAT) 12 STS

SR1(RS): P4, C4B, P4

SR2(WS): K4, P4, K4

SR3(RS): P3, T3B, T3F, P3

SR4(WS): K3, P2, K2, P2, K3

SR5(RS): P2, T3B, P2, T3F, P2

SR6(WS): K2, P2, K4, P2, K2

SR7(RS): P2, K2, P4, K2, P2

SR8(WS): K2, P2, K4, P2, K2

SR9(RS): P2, T3F, P2, T3B, P2

SR10(WS): K3, P2, K2, P2, K3

SR11(RS): P3, T3F, T3B, P3

SR12(WS): K4, P4, K4

SREP R1 ~ SR12 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

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POCKET DESIGN (26 STS)

PR1(RS): P2, T3B, P5, C6B, P5, T3F, P2

PR2(WS): K2, P2, K6, P6, K6, P2, K2

PR3(RS): P1, T3B, P4, T5B, T5F, P4, T3F, P1

PR4(WS): K1, P2, K5, P3, K4, P3, K5, P2, K1

PR5(RS): T3B, P3, T5B, P4, T5F, P3, T3F

PR6(WS): P2, K1, MB, K2, P3, K8, P3, K2, MB, K1, P2

PR7(RS): T3F, P3, K3, P8, K3, P3, T3B

PR8(WS): K1, P2, K3, P3, K8, P3, K3, P2, K1

PR9(RS): P1, T3F, P2, T5F, P4, T5B, P2, T3B, P1

PR10(WS): K2, P2, (K4, P3)X2, K4, P2, K2

PR11(RS): P2, T3F, P3, T5F, T5B, P3, T3B, P2

PR12(WS): K1, MB, K1, P2, K5, P6, K5, P2, K1, MB, K1

REP PR1 ~ PR12 AS MANY AS YOU CAN

FIRST AND LAST 5 STS ARE ALL KNIT (GARTER STS)

IF YOU HAVE MORE STS TOTAL FOR POCKET, YOU CAN ST ST (RS: K, WS: P)

T3B (TWIST 3 BACK): SL1 (CN) & HOLD IT BACK, K2 (LN), P1 (CN)

T3F (TWIST 3 FRONT): SL2 (CN) & HOLD IT FRONT, P1 (LN), K2 (CN)

C6B (CABLE 6 BACK): SL3 (CN) & HOLD IT BACK, K3 (CN), K3 (CN)

T5B (TWIST 5 BACK): SL2 (CN) & HOLD IT BACK, K3 (LN), P2 (CN)

T5F (TWIST 5 FRONT): SL3 (CN) & HOLD IT FRONT, P2 (LN), K3 (CN)

MB (MAKE BUBBLE): KFBF, (TURN K THESE 3 STS) X3, TURN, SL1, K2TOG, PSSO

FINISH ON EVEN # OF ROW (WS)

FOLLOW YOUR PATTERN

(RS): 6 BIND OFF, CONTINUE PATTERN UNTIL LAST 6 STS BEFORE MID ST, 12 BIND OFF, CONTINUE PATTERN UNTIL LAST 6 STS, 6 BIND OFF

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NOW KNIT ONLY FRONT PS FIRST WHICH MEANS KNIT IN FLAT

CREATING ARM OPENING (DECREASING): EXCEPT ARM, CONTINUE PATTERN

1. (WS): ALL PURL
2. (RS): K1, SSK X3, CONTINUE PATTERN UNTIL LAST 7 STS, K2TOG X3, K1
3. (WS): ALL PURL
4. (RS): K1, SSK, CONTINUE PATTERN UNTIL LAST 3 STS, K2TOG, K1
5. (WS): ALL PURL

REP R4 ~ R5 IN TOTAL OF 7 TIMES

I DECREASED IN TOTAL OF 16 STS IN 17 ROWS (AFTER THIS NO MORE DECREASING FOR ARM OPENING)

PLACKET (ADD MARKERS 8STS) – TRANSFER PLACKET STS ONTO ST HOLDER

AND KEEP KNITTING UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH – STOP 4 ROWS BEFORE

ON RS, KEEP KNITTING SHOULDERS FOR NEXT 4 ROWS, AND TRANSFER NECK STS ONT SCRAP YARN

AFTER COMPLETE SHOULDERS, TRANSFER STS ONTO STS HOLDERS

BACK PS – SAME AS FRONT PS, BUT NO PLACKET – SAME ROWS AS FRONT PS (MINE WOULD BE 61 ROWS EXCEPT LAST 4 ROWS)

KNIT SHOULDER PARTS 4 ROWS MORE THAN NECK (TRANSFER ALL NECK STS ONTO SCRAP YARN)

**** KITCHENER STS FOR SHOULDER *****

1. KNIT FRONT ST & OFF
2. PURL FRONT ST & STAY
3. PURL BACK ST & OFF
4. KNIT BACK ST & STAY

**** ARM OPENING ****

KNIT UP IN ROUND: MULTIPLE OF 4

(K2, P2) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

CAST OFF

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**** NECK ****

TRANSFER ALL STS FROM SCRAP YARN

KNIT OVER KNIT STS, & KNIT UP WHEN THERE IS NO ST: MUST BE MULTIPLE OF 4 + 2

MINE: 78

(K2, P2), K2 OR (P2, K2), P2 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

CAST OFF

**** PLACKET (WATCH VEDEO) ****

PR1 (RS): KNIT UP FROM BOTTOM TO TOP

PR2 (WS): (P2, K2), P2 + P1 FROM BOTTOM

PR3 (RS): K2TOG (1 WITH BOTTOM, & 1ST ST), THEN K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

PR4 (WS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS + P1 OR P2TOG FROM BOTTOM

REP PR3 ~ PR4 UNTIL BOTTOM STS ARE GONE

WRITE HOW MANY ROWS YOU KNITTED

THE OTHER SIDE OF PLACKET

KNIT UP SAME STS AS THE OTHER ONE

KNIT SAME ROWS AS YOU KNITTED, THEN CAST OFF

SEW BOTTOM PART

MAKING A PATTERN

1. TAKE A GAUGE AT LEAST 4" X 4": MINE 23 STS X 29 ROWS
2. MEASURE THE WIDEST PART & DECIDE HOW WIDE YOU WANT: MINE 16"
3. MATH
 $23 / 4" : X / 16"$
 $23 \times 16 / 4 = 92$ THIS IS STS FOR 1 SIDE, SO MY CAST WOULD BE 184 ~ 200
4. CASTS SHOULD BE MULTIPLE OF 4, SO I PICKED 200 CASTS TO START
5. FRONT STS / 3, MINE: $100 / 6 = 16$: THIS IS A BASE #
6. ARM OPENING & SHOULDER = JUST BASE #: MINE 16 STS EACH
7. NECK = LEFTOVER STS : MINE $100 - (16 \times 4) = 36$
8. ARM OPENING DECREASING MATH
ARM OP STS / 3: MINE $16 / 3 = 5.3333$,
MY DECREASE PLAN IS BIND OFF 6
AND DECREASE 3 STS ON NEXT RS: $16 - 6 - 3 = 7$
THEN DECREASE 1 ST EVERY OTHER ROWS ON RS FOR 7 TIMES

(EXAMPLE) IF YOUR ARM OPENING STS ARE 20
 $20 / 3 = 6.77777$
BIND OFF 7 ON RS
AND DECREASE 3 STS ON NEXT RS: $20 - 7 - 3 = 10$
THEN DECREASE 1 ST EVERY OTHER ROWS ON RS FOR 10 TIMES

OR

BIND OFF 7 ON RS
AND DECREASE 3 STS ON NEXT RS: $20 - 7 = 10$
DECREASE 2 STS NEXT 2 RS ROWS = $10 - 2 \times 2 = 6$
THEN, DECREASE 1 ST EVERY OTHER ROWS ON RS FOR 6 TIMES
