DIY KNIT V NECK VEST [COMPLETE SEAMLESS]

Hello Love Knitters!

The other day I knitted the TOP DOWN COMPLETE SEAMLESS ROUND NECK VEST, now I knitted V NECK one! It was so much fun to knit this project!

YARN: LOOPS & THREADS JOY DK TRICOT DOUBLE BONHEUR #3 – I USED A LITTLE MORE THAN 1.5 BALLS

NEEDLE: 3 & 4 MM

SWATCH WITH 4 MM: 4" ACCROSS = 22 STS

SIZE: SMALL 5'10" & 100 LB, I CAN WEAR LOOSELY

I WANT TO KNIT 38" AT THE BOTTOM OF THE VEST

4' VS 19" = 22 STS VS X STS

4X = 19 X 22

X = 19 X 22 / 4

X = 418 / 4 = 104.5

I DECIDED TO HAVE 104 STS FOR EACH BACK & FRONT

100 – 40 STS = 64

40 STS ARE TOTAL OF INCREASING FOR BOTH RIGHT (20 STS) & LEFT (20 STS)

IF YOU WANT TO INCREASE MORE, YOU CAN DO IT TOO

CAST ON: 64 WITH CONTRAST COLOR OF YARN (MUST BE MULTIPLE OF 2)

R1(RS): ALL KNIT

R2(WS): ALL PURL

PATTERN BY BEGINNER'S LUCKRAFT

REP R1 & R2 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH WHERE ARM INCREASING STARTS: 30 ROWS BEFORE END OF ARM OPENING.

I KNITTED 50 ROWS TOTAL

ARM INCREASE

IR1 (RS): K1, M1R, K UNTIL LAST 1 ST, M1L, K1

IR2 (WS): ALL PURL

REP IR1 & IR2 TOTAL OF 14 TIMES + IR1 WHICH MEANS 29 ROWS TOTAL

I KNITTED TOTAL OF $50 + 29 = 79$ ROWS

AFTER YOU FINISH INCREASEING, TRANSFER ALL THE BOTTOM STS ONTO SCRAP YARN

DIVIDE BY 3 PARTS, 2 SHOULDER PARTS, AND NECK

64 STS TOTAL = 18 STS / 28 STS / 18 STS (THIS IS HOW I DIVIDED)

STARTING WITH LEFT SHOULDER (MUST FACE TO RS), TRANSFER REST OF THE STS ONTO ST HOLDER

**** SHOULDER WRAP & TURN SHORT ROW (LEFT SHOULDER) ****

SLR1 (RS): SSK, K2, YFS1P YB TRANSFER SL ST BACK, TURN

SLR2 (WS): ALL PURL, TURN

SLR3 (RS): SSK, K UNTIL WRAP, UNWRAP, K2, YFSL1P YB TRANSFER SL ST BACK, TURN

SLR4 (WS): ALL PURL, TURN

SLR5 (RS): SSK, K UNTIL WRAP, UNWRAP, K2, YFSL1P YB TRANSFER SL ST BACK, TURN

SLR6 (WS): ALL PURL, TURN

SLR7 (RS): K UNTIL WRAP, UNWRAP, K2, YFSL1P YB TRANSFER SL ST BACK, TURN

SLR8 (WS): ALL PURL. TURN

I KNITTED TOTAL OF $50 + 29 + 8 = 87$ ROWS

THIS IS END OF BACK PS, YOU NEED TO REMEMBER THIS TOTAL ROWS YOU KNITTED.

COUNT SHOULDER STS: IT SHOULD BE -3 FROM ORIGINAL

$18 - 3 = 15$ STS FOR MINE

HALF OF NECK INC (SHAPE OF V NECK)

$28/2+3=17$, $17 \times 3=51$

WHOLE NECK STS / 2 + STS THE YOU DEC FOR SHAPE OF NECK X 3 = ROWS YOU WILL KNIT TO COMPLETE MAKING HALF OF V NECK

**** FRONT PS START (LEFT)****

LFR1(RS): K1, M1R, K UNTIL END (BUT 1ST ROW, YOU MUST UNWRAP)

LFR2(WS): ALL PURL

LFR3(RS): ALL KNIT

LFR4(WS): ALL PURL UNTIL LAST 2 ST, M1LP, P1

LFR5(RS): ALL KNIT

LFR6(WS): ALL PURL

REP LFR1 ~ LFR6 UNTIL YOU MAKE A HALF OF YOUR V NECK PART WHICH IS (HALF NECK STS + # OF SSK) / 14 STS + 3 STS = 17 TIMES FOR ME

I DID TOTAL OF $17 \times 3 = 51$ ROWS, AND LEAVE IT THERE, THEN MOVE ONTO RIGHT SIDE OF SHOULDER

**** SHOULDER WRAP & TURN SHORT ROW (RIGHT SHOULDER) ****

SRR1 (WS): P2TOG, P2, YBS1P YF TRANSFER SL ST BACK, TURN

PATTERN BY BEGINNER'S LUCKRAFT

SRR2 (RS): ALL KNIT, TURN

SRR3 (WS): P2TOG, P UNTIL WRAP, UNWRAP, P2, YBSL1P YF TRANSFER SL ST BACK, TURN

SRR4 (RS): ALL KNIT, TURN

SRR5 (WS): P2TOG UNTIL WRAP, UNWRAP, P2, YBSL1P YF TRANSFER SL ST BACK, TURN

SRR6 (RS): ALL KNIT, TURN

SRR7 (WS): P UNTIL WRAP, UNWRAP, P2, YBSL1P YF TRANSFER SL ST BACK, TURN

SRR8 (RS): ALL KNIT, TURN

**** FRONT PS START (RIGHT)****

RFR1(WS): P1, M1RP, ALL PURL UNTIL END (BUT 1ST ROW, YOU MUST UNWRAP)

RFR2(RS): ALL KNIT

RFR3(WS): ALL PURL

RFR4(RS): ALL KNIT UNTIL LAST 1 ST, M1L, K1

RFR5(WS): ALL PURL

RFR6(RS): ALL KNIT

REP RFR1 ~ RFR6 UNTIL YOU MAKE A HALF OF YOUR V NECK PART WHICH IS (HALF NECK STS + # OF SSK)
/ 14 STS + 3 STS = 17 TIMES FOR ME

I DID TOTAL OF $17 \times 3 = 51$ ROWS

***** CONNECT FRONT PS R52 *****

ALL KNIT (RIGHT SHOULDER), ADD NEW 1 CAST, ALL KNIT (LEFT SHOULDER)

ST ST UNTIL ARM INCREASE STARTS

FOR ME, 7 ROWS INCLUDING CONNECT ROW

R53 (RS): ALL PURL

CONTINUE ST ST UNTIL R58 WHICH IS ARM INC STARTS

PATTERN BY BEGINNER'S LUCKRAFT

*** FRONT ARM INC ***

R59(WS): ALL PURL

R60(RS): K1, M1R, K UNTIL LAST 1 ST, M1L, K1

CONTINUE RS & WS UNTIL 15 STS INC DONE

*** CONNECT BOTH FRONT & BACK ***

BACK R87

FRONT R88

WHENEVER YOU FINISH R88 FOR FRONT, ADD 5+5 NEW CASTS, AND KNIT BACK PS UNTIL THE OTHER SIDE, THEN ADD 5+5 NEW CASTS, NOW YOU WILL KNIT IN ROUND

KNIT UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

CHANGE THE NEEDLE TO 3.5 MM

RIB: (K1, P1) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH AND CAST OFF

*** ARM OPENING ***

KNIT UP: MULTIPLE OF 2: (K1, P1) UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH AND CAST OFF

*** NECK OPENING ***

KNIT UP: MULTIPLE OF 2 + 1 MID STITCH

R1: (K1, P1) UNTIL 1 LAST ST BEFORE MID STITCH, SLIP 2 STS KNITWISE, K1, PSSO, (K1, P1)

CONTINUE R1 UNTIL YOUR DEISIRE LENGTH, AND CAST OFF
