YARN: LEFTOVER YARN #4

NEEDLE: 4 MM

SWATCH & GAUGE: 2" = 20 STS

DESIRE NECK MEASUREMENT: 13"

DOG: 10 LB YORKIE

CAST ON: 70 OR MULTIPLE OF 10

PREP: (K2, P2, K4, P2) ONLY 1 ROW BUT COUNT AS R1

[NECK RIB]

R1(RS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

R2(WS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

R3(RS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

R4(WS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

R5(RS): (K2, P2, C4F, P2)

R6(WS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

REP R1 ~ R6 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE NECK LENGTH

I DID 3 TIMES

ALL PURL

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ALL KNIT

ALL PURL

[LEASH OPENING] BEST ROW TO START IS R1 & 2

R1: BIND OFF IN BETWEEN LEASH MARKERS (8 STS)

R2: ADD NEW CASTS (8 STS)

[INCREASING RULE]

1. WITH BACK NEEDLE
2. IN THE MIDDLE
3. USE KFB
4. FROM EVEN TO ODD:  $\frac{1}{2} + 1$
5. FROM ODD TO EVEN:  $(+1) / 2$

[INCREASE]

IR1(RS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

IR2(WS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

IR3(RS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

IR4(WS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

IR5(RS): (K2, P2, C4→5F, P2)

C4→5F: P/U 3 WITH CABLE & HOLD IT FRONT, KFB ON LN, K3 ON CN

IR6(WS): K OVER K STS, P OVER P STS

[C4→5F] P/U 3 STS WITH CN & HOLD IT AT THE FRONT, KFB FROM LN, K3 FROM CN

[C5F] P/U 3 STS WITH CN & HOLD IT AT THE FRONT, K2 FROM LN, K3 FROM CN

[C5→6F] P/U 3 STS WITH CN & HOLD IT AT THE FRONT, (K1, KFB) FROM LN, K4 FROM CN

[C6F] P/U 3 STS WITH CN & HOLD IT AT THE FRONT, K3 FROM LN, K3 FROM CN

[C6→7F] P/U 4 STS WITH CN & HOLD IT AT THE FRONT, (K1, KFB) FROM LN, K4 FROM CN

[C7F] P/U 4 STS WITH CN & HOLD IT AT THE FRONT, K3 FROM LN, K3 FROM CN

[C7→8F] P/U 4 STS WITH CN & HOLD IT AT THE FRONT, (K2, KFB) FROM LN, K4 FROM CN

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[C8F] P/U 4 STS WITH CN & HOLD IT AT THE FRONT, K4 FROM LN, K4 FROM CN

**\*\* INCREASE FOMULA \*\***

EVEN STS # → ODD STS #

STS COUNT / 2 + 1 WILL BE FRONT

(FRONT) LEFT TWIST: KFB AT LAST

(BACK) RIGHT TWIST: KFB AT FIRST

ODD STS # → EVEN STS #

(STS COUNT + 1) / 2 WILL BE FRONT

(FRONT) LEFT TWIST: KFB AT LAST

(BACK) RIGHT TWIST: KFB AT FIRST

[LEG OPENING] YOU CAN DO SAME AS LEASH OPENING, ADD MARKERS

LR1: KNIT WHATEVER ROW WITH SCRAP YARN & TRANSFER BACK, THEN KNIT WITH MAIN YARN

BEST TIME TO DO THIS IS R6 OR R1

AFTER YOU KNIT A FEW ROWS,

PICK UP ALL TOP & BOTTOM STS WITH 2 DIFFERENT SCRAP YARN (WATCH VIDEO)

CONTINUE TO KNIT UNTIL ENOUGH LENGTH FOR TUMMY

WHEN YOU KNIT ENOUGH FOR TUMMY, TRANSFER ALL TUMMY STS ON R6

THEN START KNITTING ONLY BACK PART IN FLAT WITH DECREASE FOR BOTH ENDS

[DECREASE]

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LEFT LEANING PURL: P2TOG

LEFT LEANING KNIT: SSK

RIGHT LEANING PURL: P2TOG WITH BL

RIGHT LEANING KNIT: K2TOG

[DEC WITH CABLE]

- P/U 4 STS WITH CN & HOLD IT FRONT, K3 ON LN, K2TOG, K2 ON CN
- P/3 3 STS WITH CN & HOLD IT FRONT, K2, K2TOG ON LN, K3 ON CN

WHEN YOU KNIT ENOUGH FOR BACK, RECONNECT

[RECONNECT]

ALL PURL, FOR SIDE PART, KNIT UP

[GARTER ST IN ROUND]

GR1: ALL KNIT

GR2: ALL PURL

REP GR1 & GR2 UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

[BIND OFF]

WITH 1 SIZE BIGGER NEEDLE

[SLEEVE]

KNIT WHATEVER ROW IN ROUND FOR SIDE PART, KNIT UP 2 STS EACH

AND CARRY ONTO THE PATTERN UNTIL YOUR DESIRE LENGTH

BIND OFF WITH 1 SIZE BIGGER NEEDLE

[ABBREVIATIONS]

RS=RIGHT SIDE

WS=WRONG SIDE

IR=INCREASE ROW

K2TOG=KNIT 2 TOGETHER

BL P2TOG=BACK LOOP PURL 2 TOGETHER

SSK=SLIP SLIP KNIT

LT=LEFT

RT=RIGHT
